We know that Term 3 is already beginning to be a very busy term. We wanted to send a short note to help you keep track of some of the dates / events.

Mardi Gras 2017 - Tuesday 28th February

This will be a *non uniform day* and children can wear the traditional Mardi Gras colours of GREEN, PURPLE OR GOLD or any bright colour. Please make sure the clothes are suitable for a day at school and a visit to church.

Children will be working on different activities throughout the day with various teaching staff, on the theme of Mardi Gras. They will visit the church in the afternoon. Parents are not invited to this event and children are to be collected at normal time from the school.

Readathon - Week of Monday 27th February 2017

This is an idea that School Council have asked for to help raise money for more books in school and for charity. We have scheduled it this week to link in with World Book Day. A letter and information / sponsor form was sent home by Miss Miller on 22.2.17.

World Book Day - Thursday 2nd March (A letter has previously been sent out by Miss Miller and can be found on the website)

Children to dress up as a book character. School Council have been discussing ways in which we can raise resources and have asked that, instead of donating £1 to dress up, children donate a book to the school.
